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Hi Tom,

The PKCF TARP condition/status for the NW Decant Water Elevation has been downgraded/improved to a YELLOW condition with NW Decant Pond water level of 464.44 m (it was 464.50 m in my previous notification to you). There was no flow from the spillway in the past 24 hours; however, as reported previously, we have had intermittent flow through the spillway to Pond 3 during the month.

Pumping of decant water from Pond 3 to the North Inlet began on May 23. The Pond 3 water level is 425.10 m (it was 426.16 m in my previous notification to you), with 205,000 cubic meters of remaining capacity up to the 428.5 m elevation above which is required to store the Inflow Design Flood (IDF).
