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Hi Tom,

The PKCF TARP condition/status for the NW Decant Water Elevation remains steady at GREEN condition with NW Decant Pond water level of 465.26 m (it was 465.11 m in my previous notification to you).

The Pond 3 water elevation TARP status is GREEN at 423.72 m (it was 422.90 m in my previous notification to you), with approximately 242,000 cubic meters of remaining capacity up to the 427.4 m elevation above which is required to store the Inflow Design Flood (IDF).

CPK placement in the PKCF is at GREEN condition i.e., no triggers for actions have been activated in the PKCF.

PKCF Collection Pond 4 Seepage Update:

- The till berm (long-term solution for the occasional seepage) has been successfully constructed to intercept and direct seepage to Collection Pond 4.
- Additional work will be done within the trench to ensure any subsequent water flow is directed to Pond 4.
