Please see the hyperlink to view the GNWT-INF's submission of [Version 1.2 of the Waste Management Plan](#) for the Tlįcho All-season Road (TASR). In the cover letter of Version 1.2 of the Waste Management Plan, GNWT-INF states that:

Version 1.2 has named the City of Yellowknife's sewage facility as a potential receiver of sewage from the work Camp rather than the existing wording that speaks simply to municipal lagoons in general. Due to capacity issues with the sewage facility in Behchokò, which was identified as an example of a sewage lagoon location as indicated in Version 1.1 of the WMP, the sewage will now be transported to the City of Yellowknife.

Included in Appendix E of Version 1.2 is authorization from the City of Yellowknife to have TAsR-related Waste disposed of in the lagoon and landfill. Board staff also note that Version 1.2 has been revised to reflect Decision #8 of the Board's direction from the [August 23, 2019 Reasons for Decision](#) and are expecting a Water Licence Amendment Application shortly.

Due to the scale of the revisions, no public review is being initiated at this time. This email is intended to provide Parties an opportunity to provide comments and/or indicate whether they believe a public review of the Waste Management Plan is necessary. If any Party wishes to initiate a public review, please provide rationale directly to rfequet@wlwb.ca on or before 16:00 Mountain Time on Friday, October 18, 2019.
