Hi LeeAnn,

This email is to follow-up on Board staff's phone conversation on Friday afternoon (May 15th) with the Community Government of Wekweèti (CGW) regarding the CGW's 2019 Annual Report which was due on March 31st but has not yet been received. Board staff understand that the CGW currently has no SAO in the community and is waiting for the chief and council's approval before a new hired SAO can arrive in the community.

On March 3, 2020, Board staff sent a reminder letter for the Annual Report along with the template ([see link here](#)). During the phone call, the CGW staff requested an example of the Annual Report. See link below for the 2018 Annual Report submitted by the CGW on February 21, 2019:
