

ACCESS ROAD ENGAGEMENT PLAN

BACKGROUND:

Rover has received WLWB Land Use Permit W2018C0002. This plan has been submitted and approved as part of the Land Use Permit. A copy has been included in Appendix 5 of the "Access to Tłįchǫ Lands Agreement for a Road to the Cabin Lake Property Project" ("Access Agreement").

Upon approval of the Access Agreement, Rover intends to apply for an amendment of its existing Land Use Permit to include the Tłycho Access Agreement. Appendix 5 will be updated with the amended LUP.

This Access Road Engagement Plan is an extension of the WLWB Land Use Plan.

ENGAGEMENT OBJECTIVES:

- Clearly provide information about the project to potentially affected parties and organizations with jurisdictional interests.
- Provide opportunity for these parties to review the information and provide comment on the project.
- Develop project plans and designs which consider the comments and concerns of potentially affected parties.

ENGAGEMENT PRINCIPLES:

The community engagement methods employed by Rover incorporate the following principles:

- Information provided that is accessible to community representatives. This requires understanding of the communication methods and formats that work for community members.
- Adequate time and resources made available for community representatives to review and thoroughly understand the material provided.
- Incorporation of community concerns and comments in project planning.
- Reflection back to community members of the comments and concerns identified and how these have been considered in project planning.



ACCESS ROAD ENGAGEMENT PLAN

PROCEDURE:

The Access Road Engagement Plan will set out the manner in which Rover will engage with the Tłıcho Government and Tłıcho communities on issues concerning the Access Road, including but not limited to:

- Heritage resource protection
- Safety
- Environmental Matters
- Operational Matters
- Accident reports
- Spill reporting. The Access Holder will review and provide any updates to the Access Road Management Plan annually for approval by Tłįcho

DETAILS:

HERITAGE RESOURCE PROTECTION:

Rover will abide by the Wildlife, Archaeology, and Environment Plan in its WLWB Land Use Permit W2018C002 until the amended LUP is awarded, upon which it will abide by the amended permit.

SAFETY

Rover will ensure that all personnel are trained and are provided the necessary PPE to safely perform work. Preference will be given to contractors and consultants that have COR training. Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's) for work tasks will be used when required.

FNVIRONMENTAL

Rover will abide by the Wildlife, Archaeology, and Environment Plan in its WLWB Land Use Permit W2018C002 until the amended LUP is awarded, upon which it will abide by the amended permit.

ACCIDENT REPORTS

Rover will report all accidents and incidents to the Tłįchǫ Government.
