UPDATED ENGAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE NIGHTHAWK GOLD CORP INDIN LAKE GOLD PROPERTY

Dear Mr. Mackenzie,

Nighthawk Gold Corp. (Nighthawk) re-submits Version 3.2 of the Engagement Plan for approval by the Wek'èezhìı Land and Water Board (the Board) pursuant to W2018C0007 and W2018X0006.

Version 3.2 includes engagement triggers specific to closure and reclamation, as directed by the Board in the Reasons for Decision dated 24 January 2019. Specifically, triggers have been included for any updates to the Closure and Reclamation Plan, or initiation of closure or reclamation activities. Other minor editorial updates have also been made.

Further to this, the Prince of Wales Northern Heritage Centre (PWNHC) have been removed from the list of affected parties. As the PWNHC does not meet the definition of an affected party under the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board Engagement Guidelines, and as archaeological sites are protected by conditions under Section 26(1)(j) of W2018C0007 and W2018X0006, there is no need to include the PWNHC as an affected party in the Engagement Plan. PWNHC have been contacted and agree with this decision.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This document is Nighthawk Gold Corp's (Nighthawk's) Engagement Plan for use at the Indin Lake Gold Project (the Project), encompassing camp operations at the Colomac Camp, fuel storage at the Colomac, Damoti Lake and Diversified camps and exploration activities in the Indin Lake region in the Northwest Territories (NWT). Nighthawk is a junior gold exploration company whose primary exploration property is the Indin Lake Gold Project located in the Wek'èezhìı region of the NWT. The Wek'èezhìi region is the management area of the Tłįcho Government (TG), with the Wek'èezhìi Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) having the wildlife co-management authority for the region as established by the Tłįcho Agreement. The TG represents the communities of Behchokò, Gamètì, Wekweètì, and Whatì. The North Slave Métis Alliance (NSMA) represents the rights of the Métis people of the Great Slave Lake area, primarily in the region north and east of Great Slave Lake, NWT.

This Engagement Plan is intended to outline Nighthawk's engagement to properly inform and collaborate with affected parties. It was prepared following the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board's Engagement Guidelines for Applicants and Holders of Water Licences (MVLWB 2014) and Land Use Permits and Engagement and Consultation Policy (MVLWB 2013).

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB) defines engagement as "the communication and outreach activities a proponent undertakes with affected parties prior to and during the operation of a project". The level of engagement should reflect the scale, location and nature of a proposed activity (MVLWB 2014). An affected party is defined as "a party that is predicted to be affected by a proposed project, such as an Aboriginal organization/government, an individual occupying land for traditional purposes, a private landowner, or lease holder" (MVLWB 2014).

An Engagement Record (i.e., a summary detailing the engagement processes and outcomes) is provided in Appendix A.

2.0 AFFECTED PARTIES AND ENGAGEMENT TRIGGERS

This section summarizes the engagement triggers as well as engagement purpose and format for each of the affected parties. The affected parties for the purposes of this Engagement Plan are:

- Tłįcho Government
- Wek'èezhìi Renewable Resource Board
- North Slave Métis Alliance

The Tł_lchǫ maintain a working group to manage the implementation of IBAs as well as mining and road related matters in the Tł_lchǫ region, the Kwe Beh Working Group. Nighthawk engaged the Kwe Beh Working Group in the past (prior to 2016) and they were included again in the 2018 pre-submission engagement.

Nighthawk understands that engagement is a process that is ongoing through the lifetime of a project. The engagement process for this Project started in 2012 and will continue throughout the upcoming phases of the Project. Nighthawk has been and will remain in contact with the affected parties, including discussions on the format of engagement.
