Dear Donovan Boucher,

Re: Northern Quality Control – Land Use Permit Application Incomplete – Gravel Parking Lot at Km 292 on Highway #3, NT

On August 24, 2020, the Wek'èezhii Land and Water Board ((WLWB or the Board) received an application from Northern Quality Control for a Land Use Permit (Permit; W2020F0004) for a gravel parking lot at kilometer 292 on Highway 3.¹ The Application has been reviewed in accordance with subsection 23(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR) and has been found to be lacking sufficient information. For the Application to be considered complete, the following information must be submitted to the WLWB:

1. Engagement Record and Plan: As described in section 3.1 of the Boards' [Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process](#), each applicant must conduct engagement prior to submitting a land use permit application. The application must include an engagement record and engagement plan, prepared in accordance with section 2.1 of the Boards' [Engagement and Consultation Policy](#) and the Boards' [Engagement Guidelines for Applicants and Holders of Water Licences and Land Use Permits](#) (Guidelines). As per Appendix B of the Guidelines, engagement for a Land Use Permit application requires written notification to the affected party, confirmation of receipt, and follow-up (if necessary) with affected parties. The engagement information provided by Northern Quality Control does not include an Engagement Record for all parties included in the Pre-Engagement Submission Contact List that was provided on April 28, 2020. To consider the application complete, Northern Quality Control should provide evidence of written notification, confirmation of receipt, and follow-up (if necessary) with that Northwest Territories Treaty 8 Tribal Corporation, the Kitikmeot Inuit Association, Yellowknives Dene First Nation, Deninu Kue First Nation, Lutsel K'e Dene First Nation, the Government of

Northwest Territories – Prince of Northern Wales Northern Heritage Centre (GNWT-PWNHC),
and GNWT Environment and Natural Resources as part of the pre-submission engagement.

When resubmitting the Application package, please include all the relevant components of the Application package (including items that may have been previously submitted).

If this information is not provided within 90 days of the date of this letter, then it shall be assumed that you do not wish to continue with the processing of this application, and the application will be returned to you as per Section 25 of the MVLUR.
