**Tłıchų All Season Road Type A Water Licence Application Package**

The Government of the Northwest Territories' Department of Infrastructure (GNWT-INF) is pleased to submit an application for a Type A Water Licence for the Tłıchų All Season Road. The Tłıchų All Season Road is currently operating under Land Use Permit W2016E0004 and Type B Water Licence W2016L8-0001. The Type A Water Licence will allow for water withdrawal to support construction activities such as road compaction, dust suppression, winter road construction, and camp use. The water withdrawal is expected to start on July 1, 2020. Further details are included in the attached documents.

Management Plans to support this application are found on the Wek'èezhì Land and Water Boards Public Registry for the Tłıchų All Season Road. These are; Spill Contingency Plan, Waste Management Plan, Fish and Fish Habitat Protection Plan, Water Monitoring Plan, Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan, Erosion and Sediment Control Plan and Archaeological Chance Find Protocol. The existing mitigation methods detailed in these plans will be followed to ensure environmental impacts remain minimal.

There are no additional impacts anticipated from the extraction of increased water volumes (from 300m<sup>3</sup>/day to 900m<sup>3</sup>/day) related to this application. This is based on the understanding that the increased water volumes extracted will not come from only one source but rather at the previously approved locations listed in Section 7 (above). Water extraction will proceed from these locations after all the appropriate bathymetric and hydraulic assessments are completed and will also follow the established withdrawal limits from existing regulatory protocols such as the 2010 Protocol for Winter Water Withdrawal in the Northwest Territories and Nunavut. Additionally, all current mitigation measures/constraints currently in place for the project will be maintained such as the use of fish screens and daily water volume tracking. Proposed groundwater extractions are well removed from any permanent watercourses or wetland features and will be at a depth and rate of extraction that will preclude the potential for well interference on any significant environmental feature. 

The additional water volume is required for compaction of roadway embankment material and gravel placement compaction, scheduled for 2020 and 2021, and general day-to-day dust suspension needs on our haul roads. INF's current Type B Water License volume of 299 m3/day is inadequate for our projected 2020 and 2021 demand.
