To the Parties of the Nighthawk Water Licences and Permit Applications Proceeding,

**Re: Undertakings from the Nighthawk Water Licences and Land Use Permit Applications Public Hearing**

The Wek'èezhì Land and Water Board (WLWB) would like to thank all Parties who participated in the recent public hearing in Yellowknife, NT on April 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 to discuss Nighthawk's Water Licences and Land Use Permit Applications for the Indin Lake Project. The public hearing was beneficial in helping to identify and clarify several issues raised by interveners and the public.

There were undertakings requested in order to ensure additional evidence is on the record for this proceeding, which will allow Parties to refine their positions within their closing arguments, and to allow the Board to make an informed decision. The WLWB is requesting the following information from Parties:

**Undertaking #1 for Nighthawk**

Nighthawk to provide a hyperlink to the water quality model submitted to the Board on November 19, 2021 to be added to the record of this proceeding.

**Undertaking #2 for Nighthawk**

Nighthawk to propose acute toxicity testing requirements for SNP 5-6 to reflect its response to Interventions.

**Undertaking #3 for Nighthawk**

Nighthawk to provide clarity on what a satellite camp will consist of (e.g., number of people, footprint, fuel storage, wastewater, greywater, structures) and propose a definition for "satellite camp" that could be included in the relevant authorizations.

**Undertaking #4 for GNWT**

GNWT to provide its closure cost estimate in Microsoft Excel format.

**Undertaking #5 for Nighthawk**

Nighthawk to identify if bulk sampling, management of waste rock, and management of ore, beyond the Damoti site, were previously subject to Part 5 of the MVRMA. If so, provide the supporting documentation.

All information requested must be submitted to the WLWB electronically on or before **Friday, April 22, 2022**. All information regarding this proceeding will be circulated to the Nighthawk Distribution List and posted on the WLWB's Online Registry as soon as possible.
