**RE: Nighthawk – Water Licence Amendment Applications and Land Use Permit Application – Technical Workshop - Information Request #19**

In review of Nighthawk's responses to Information Requests (IR) #3, 10, and 18,<sup>1</sup> it appears that Nighthawk wishes to include bulk sampling, the use of the Settling Pond, and Discharge from the Settling Pond (SNP Station 5-2) within the scope of the proposed authorizations. As this differs from what was communicated at the Technical Workshop, and in an effort to ensure that sufficient evidence is on the record so Parties can make comprehensive submissions to the Board, the WLWB is requesting the following information from Nighthawk no later than **March 6, 2022**. This Information Request is issued in accordance with Rules 61 and 63 of the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board's Rules of Procedure.<sup>2</sup>

**IR #19 for Nighthawk**

- a) Nighthawk to describe how the proposed effluent quality criteria for SNP Station 5-2 are consistent with the MVLWB Water and Effluent Quality Management Policy (2011).<sup>3</sup> This should specifically address how the proposed EQC will achieve the two objectives for regulating the deposit of waste described in section 6.0 of the Policy; and
- b) Nighthawk to describe how the proposed effluent quality criteria for the controlled Discharge at SNP Station 5-2 will ensure that the proposed effluent quality criteria for the passive Discharge at SNP Station 5-6 are met.
