Further to our telephone conversation of today, this is to indicate I am in receipt of your letter dated August 13, 2021 for the above application which will expire in January 2022.

I understand CIRNAC-CARD is not proposing any new activities outside of those already permitted. Further, the scope of the new applications will largely decrease to what is currently permitted; the new applications will only include activities relating to Long Term Monitoring, all activities related to the remediation phase have been removed.
