



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Project: Snare Hydroelectric Facility

Location: Snare River, NT

Purpose: The Northwest Territories Power Corporation (NTPC) submitted an Application to renew Type A Water Licences N1L4-0150 and W2014L4-0001. The scope of the Project includes the already licenced hydroelectric generation plants and associated structures at Snare Rapids, Snare Falls, and Snare Forks (currently under Water Licence N1L4-0150), as well as Snare Cascades (currently under Water Licence W2014L4-0004). NTPC is applying to combine the Water Licences into one Licence. Currently, the Snare Cascades Facility is owned by Dogrib Power Corporation (DPC) but operated by NTPC. NTPC provided a letter from DPC indicating that DPC supports combining the plants into one Licence.

A public hearing will be held by the Board to fulfill subsection 41(2)(a) of the *Waters Act* on **December 6, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** The hearing will be held at the **Kô Gochô Sportsplex Centre in Behchokô, NT** in accordance with the *LWB Rules of Procedure*. An agenda will be made available through the Public Registry closer to the public hearing date.
