

5.1 The Permittee shall ensure that the land use area is kept clean and tidy at all times.

6.1 The Permittee shall remove any obstruction to natural drainage caused by any part of this land use operation.

26 (1) (h) - PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE HABITAT AND FISHERIES

8.1 The Permittee shall not unnecessarily damage wildlife habitat in conducting this land use operation.

8.2 The Permittee's employees shall not feed or harass wildlife when working on-site

26 (1) (m) - PETROLEUM FUEL STORAGE

9.1 The Permittee shall not allow petroleum products to spread to surrounding lands or into water bodies. **FUEL CONTAINMENT**

26 (1) (p) - DISPLAY OF PERMITS AND PERMIT NUMBERS

10.1 The Permittee shall keep on hand, at all times during this land use operation, a copy of the Land Use Permit **COPY OF PERMIT**

10.2 The Permittee shall conspicuously display the Land Use Permit number on all vehicles and equipment. **DISPLAY PERMIT NUMBER**

26 (1) (q) - MATTERS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE REGULATIONS

11.1 The Permittee shall provide in writing to the Board and DIAND Inspectors, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to commencement of this land use operation, the following information: **IDENTIFY AGENT**

(a) person, or persons, in charge of the field operation to whom notices, orders, and reports may be served;

(b) alternates;

(c) all the indirect methods for contacting the above person(s).

11.2 The Permittee shall not construct earth approaches abutted to the roadbed on any public highway or road, without prior approval of the Department of Transportation, Government of the Northwest Territories. **HIGHWAY APPROACHES**

11.3 The Permittee shall submit to the Board/Inspectors a contingency plan, for chemical and petroleum spills, for use during the times when operating in the pit. **CONTINGENCY PLAN**
