An inspection of the remaining structures located within the Gordon Lake land use area was completed by Resource Management Officer Tim Morton on June 29th 2023. The purpose of the report is to inform you of the remaining structures located at WestBay, Zenith Island, and Kidney Pond's condition. The structures remain in a similar condition as they were in 2022. Deterioration continues to occur as they were not constructed to remain unoccupied for extended periods of time.

The current land use permit expires on December 18th 2023 and the permit is no longer eligible for an extension as one was granted in 2021.
