Re: Information Request No. 1: Paramount Resources Ltd. (Paramount) Application for Approval to Abandon the Fort Liard F-36 Well (well ID 1841) ACW-2016-003

In response to your letter dated November 28, 2016, Paramount hereby requests an extension to the December 5, 2016 deadline.

Paramount is currently finalizing the abandonment program in conjunction with feedback from OROGO that will satisfy the regulations.

Progress and timing of items on the IR are as follows

- Item 1)* The Safety plan and Environmental Protection Plan are complete and will be submitted in the application package
- Item 2)* The dates of the last workover will be reconciled and also submitted with the application package
- Item 3)* The daily reports will be provided
- Item 4)* Will be provided
- Item 5)* As mentioned above the program is being worked on
- Item 6)* The formation tops will be provided
- Item 7)* There is a reported surface casing vent leak at F-36. Remediation plans will be incorporated into the abandonment program
- Item 8)* An updated ERP is complete and will be submitted with the application package.

Paramount anticipates that it will be ready to submit the abandonment application package by December 15, 2016 and hereby requests an extension to that date.
