Inspection of the Netla K-77 Well (WID1862)

On July 20, 2022, Mr. Brian Heppelle, Safety Officer and Conservation Officer under section 105 of the *Oil and Gas Operations Act*, inspected the Netla K-77 well (WID1862), operated by Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. (CNRL). Mr. Heppelle has since left the Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (OROGO). He did not complete an *OROGO Well Inspection Summary Report* for the Netla K-77 well inspection before he left.

In the absence of an *OROGO Well Inspection Summary Report*, I am sharing the results of our review of Mr. Heppelle's field notes and photographs taken during the inspection.

Mr. Heppelle's notes indicate that the Netla K-77 well was in satisfactory condition except:

- Brush and debris were present within 25 meters of the wellhead.

On October 11, 2022, CNRL submitted a *Well Inspection Report* for the Netla K-77 well, which indicated that there continues to be brush and debris within 25 meters of the wellhead. Clearing brush and debris within 25 meters of the wellhead is necessary to ensure safe access to the site by helicopter. As the Netla K-77 well is being abandoned during the winter 2023 work season, please note that all equipment and debris on the site must be removed with 12 months of the abandonment of the well, as required under the *Well Suspension and Abandonment Guidelines and Interpretation Notes*.
