**Well Status: Non-Compliant Suspension of the
Netla K-77 Well (WID1862) (ACW-2019-009-CNRL-K-77-WID1862 Variation 5)**

On March 8, 2023, the Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (OROGO) received the Well Operations Report summarizing the 2023 abandonment operations for the Netla K-77 well (WID1862). On May 11, 2023, OROGO received a Well Termination Record for the same well. The report and record have been reviewed and satisfy the requirements of section 89(1) and (2) of the *Oil and Gas Drilling and Production Regulations*.

Term 15 of ACW-2019-009-CNRL-K-77-WID1862 variation 5 requires Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. (CNRL) to conduct additional gas migration testing on this well between July and September 2023. This well also has a known surface casing vent flow (SCVF), which is being monitored post repair operations.

Therefore, our records have been updated identifying the status of this well as Non-Compliant Suspended.

After CNRL has completed the gas migration testing and confirmed the SCVF repair, and after OROGO has reviewed these results, CNRL may submit a Well Status Change form to request the status of the Netla K-77 well be changed to Abandoned.
