Status:	<p>August 24, 2023: Prairie Provident Resources (PPR) Operations crews experienced a wildlife encounter. There was evidence that a bear was in the area as road signs had been knocked over and there was some activity on the lease. Once crews were mobilized back to site, a bear watch expert was brought onto the lease to assess the situation. The expert was tracking the bear and attempting to scare it away. Unfortunately, on the morning of August 24th, 2023, the bear was on-site with multiple personnel on-site in close proximity. An alert was called by one of the crew members and unfortunately the bear watch expert had to dispose of the bear as it was clearly not afraid of people. The Department of Environment and Climate Change was called, and they requested that the bear was buried.</p> <p>File Closed – August 25, 2023</p>
