**RE: Abandonment of the Cameron N-28 Well (ACW-2021-SOG-N-28-WID 1753)**

ELM Inc, acting on behalf of Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc in their capacity as the receiver for Strategic Oil and Gas Ltd requests a variation to the well approval for the Cameron N-28 well.

Due to the multiple completed intervals, ELM has been unable to establish circulation on this well. ELM requests permission to use a dump bailer to place cement for the abandonment of the Keg River and Sulphur Point perforations. The Slave Point perforations will be abandoned with a circulated cement plug as per OROGO guidelines.

This variation request will replace the steps in the approved program as follows:

- 46 / 53. Run in hole with dump bailer sub on tubing.
- 47 / 54. Mix 250L of cement in mixing barrel. Pour cement into tubing and top up with water. Spud the bailer on the bridge plug to release the cement.
- 48 / 55. Slowly pull out of the cement, then pull out of the hole with tubing and stand in the derrick.
