RE: Deferral of Abandonment Program, Fort Liard Area (OA-2018-005-CNRL)

As per the Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (OROGO) approval to defer the Fort Liard area abandonment program, Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL) is hereby submitting the monitoring plan to complete more frequent testing and inspections. The plan will be to complete a visual (flyover) inspection of the wells prior to February 28, 2022. CNRL will then plan to complete inspections as per Section 5D of the Well Suspension and Abandonment Guidelines and Interpretation Notes between June 1, 2022 and July 31, 2022. Surface casing vent flow (SCVF) tests will be conducted for the A-77 and K-77 wells during these inspections. SCVF monitoring will be left on the wells to obtain build up pressures. An additional inspection as per Section 5D of the Well Suspension and Abandonment Guidelines and Interpretation Notes will be completed between September 1, 2022 and October 31, 2022. The SCVF build up tests will be retrieved from the A-77 and K-77 wells at this time.
