Notice: Environmental Liabilities at Nogha B-23 and K-14 Wellsites (OA-2019-002-MGM)

The Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (OROGO) has reviewed the NT/NU Spills Database to assess outstanding environmental liabilities under our jurisdiction. OROGO has also worked with the Canada Energy Regulator (CER) to confirm the current known status of the identified environmental liabilities, as shown in its records. Below is a list of open spills associated with wells being abandoned under OA-2019-002-MGM.

2005077	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nogha K-14 (WID2006) 300L Diesel 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> March 28, 2005, Waste manifest identified by MGM Energy but were not provided.

To further assess the status of these spills, MGM Energy is required to provide any supplementary documentation that supports work completed to address these spills. This may include but, is not limited to, waste manifests, sampling results, environmental site assessments, and remediation activities.
