Status:	<p>January 16, 2023: While making up components on rig floor, a stabilizer/reamer sub fell over making contact with individuals calf muscle, resulting in minor contact abrasion/discoloration mark on individuals' right calf. Upon onsite Medic's assessment of individual, no injury to individual sustained and no treatment administered. Worker cleared to return to work immediately. Individual was re-assessed prior to returning for their next regular scheduled shift and cleared for full/normal duties.</p> <p>February 6, 2023: Critical Task Analysis review and/or review SOP/JSA/THA SSHE Rep and Managers onsite for handling of components on rig floor. Ensure it covers the use of mechanical lifting devices and provides situational awareness mitigations measures in effort to prevent future event.</p> <p>No further action required./ FILE CLOSED</p>
