Application for an Operation Authorization - Incomplete (OA-2025-001-CNRL)

On March 31, 2025, the Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (OROGO) received an application for an Operations Authorization for the abandonment of two pipelines from the North Liard P-66 wellsite to the Liard K-29 wellsite from Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL).

I have reviewed the contents of the application package. As CNRL has not submitted an Environmental Protection Plan, the application is not complete. However, OROGO will begin its review of the information provided and will reassess application completeness when the Environmental Protection Plan is submitted.

The application package indicates CNRL submitted its Benefits Plan to the Government of the Northwest Territories for Ministerial approval on March 31, 2025. Please forward a copy of the Minister's decision to OROGO when CNRL receives it.
